### Scholarship Criteria

All applicants must be registered tribal members of Waikato-Tainui.

You should have some involvement in at least one of the following options;

- Have an intention to join the health workforce.
- Have a commitment to reducing inequalities in health for Maori including Waikato Tainui tribal members.
- Are actively involved the dissemination of health information to Waikato –Tainui tribal members.
- Are actively involved in the supporting Waikato Tainui tribal members to gain access to health services.
- Support positive health promotion, disease prevention for Waikato Tainui tribal members.

- Key learnings and highlights of the Conference.
- Any advice, suggestions or recommendations that Waikato Tainui should consider in relation to the promotion of health, disease prevention and prolonging life.
