

Koroneihana Expo

Patterson Park, Ngaruawahia

Expo Stall

The expo will run from 18 – 20 August located at Patterson Park opposite the marae.

The expo will run on a **koha** basis. This means, stallholders will set their organisation's koha to the expo. Koha received will be receipted and where required, invoices can be created and forwarded to the Stallholder for payment. All proceeds go towards supporting all activities across the whole of the Koroneihana.

Stall sites will be allocated by the expo team. Due to unforeseen circumstances there is a limited number of tables and chairs available to the expo tent this year. Stallholders are asked to supply their own equipment.

Stallholders will have access to the expo tent from 7.20am each morning. Access to the expo tent will be via the side gate on Kent Street near the rugby club. Stallholders are asked to unpack display materials and move vehicles to the car parking area by 8.30am each morning of the expo. Displays can be left set up each night. Security will patrol the area after hours however stallholders are urged to take any electronic equipment away after each day.

The expo will operate at the following times inclusive of set up:

Day 1 Wednesday 18 August 2010, Set up 9am – 5pm,
Whanau Evening 6.30pm-9.00pm,

Day 2 Thursday 19 August 2010, 9am-3pm

Day 3 Friday 20 August 2010, 9am – 3pm

The **Whanau Evening** scheduled for Wednesday 18 August 2010 is a new addition to the Expo, it is the opening night for the Expo. Providers will be able to showcase their organisation and work to the kaimahi of Koroneihana who aren't able to attend the normal operating hours of the Expo, Koroneihana Management committee and invited guests.

Please note that closing times may vary dependant on traffic through the expo site. The decision to close the expo early will be with the consensus of the stallholders.

Interactive Activities

Stallholders are encouraged to use interactive activities that engage whanau on the stall and that can be showcased within the grounds. For example, if you are promoting healthy living by exercise, your organisation may want to do prepare 15min group exercise session, if you are promoting a raaranga course you may want to consider a fashion parade showcasing your students work.

Onsite Facilities

A generator will be used to supply electricity to the expo tent however stallholders will need to supply cords etc. Kai will be available from the Whareroa, Kimiora and the area adjacent to Nga Miro Health Centre. Toilet facilities can be found behind the wardens office on the corner of George Street and on marae grounds. Port-o-loos will be opposite the papakainga entrance.

Rubbish (boxes etc) should be broken down at the end of each day and stored at the rear of the expo tent. Rubbish bins will be situated by all entrance ways.
