REGULATIONS FOR KORONEIHANA RUGBY LEAGUE 2010

RULES: The international Rugby League laws of the game are to be played excepting no 40/20 rule and that 20 players may be named on the team card for any match and all 20 players may be used in unlimited interchange.

MATCH TIMES: Games will be 30 minutes each way with 5 minutes for half time. Finals will be 30 minutes each way with 5 minutes, (note: Times are subject to change pending team registrations). No injury time is played except in the finals of each section. In the event of a draw during the semis and finals "the golden point rule will be played".

ASSEMBLY: Teams are required to be present and ready for play 10 minutes before the scheduled playing time to allow referees to make all necessary checks and allow games to commence on time. You may be defaulted if you are not ready to start on time. We would expect all teams who perform their haka, to ensure that they also assemble at least 10 minutes before the commencement of the game. This way all checks and haka will be over before the official game time will commence.

PLAYERS: Each team will comprise 20 players, plus coach/management, and the players will be declared at the start of the tournament (as per team sheets and player registration form attached). Once teams are declared, there is to be no movement of players between teams

REFEREES: Appointments will be the responsibility of the Waikato Rugby League Referee's controller appointed for the tournament.

TOUCH JUDGES: Teams may be required to supply.

TIME KEEPING: A siren will signal the start and ending of games but the Referee will have sole charge over the time keeping of all games and sin binning times.

JUDICIAL:

A player sent off will have an automatic stand down of one (1) game.

A player Sin Binned will stand down for a period of five (5) minutes.

Any player receiving a second ordering off will take no further part in the tournament unless he is exonerated of the offence for which he was dismissed.

INJURY PREVENTION:

No player shall be permitted to take part in any game without wearing a mouthguard.

Any player suffering from concussion will not be permitted to play again at the tournament.

Decisions of the St Johns Ambulance personnel regarding a player's fitness to continue playing are final.

SIN BINNING: Player's sin binned shall retire to the chairs that will be provided next to the match controllers. Players are to remain seated until their 5 minutes is up and then the Match Controller will inform the Linesman that the player's time is up.

RESERVES: Should wear jackets or some other clothing when on the sideline to distinguish them from on field players.

FOOTBALLS: Teams are to supply footballs for their games.

BALL BOYS: Teams are to supply a ball boy for each game.

FOUL LANGUAGE: Players and reserves as well as team officials/supporters will not be permitted to use foul language in and around the fields. Referees and Board members

shall have the power to refer any use of foul language to the judicial committee.

Team officials are asked to inform their supporters of these standards.

LIQUOR: No liquor is to be consumed on the sideline by any person. Offenders will be asked to leave the grounds by our security people.

CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS: Three points for a win; two points for a draw; one point for a loss, no points for a default.

If a team wins by default it will be awarded to the same points as a win. They will be awarded a 30 – 0 score line to register to their teams points.

If teams finish on equal championship points, teams qualifying for the post section play will be determined by points deferential on points for and points against.

MEDIAL ASSISTANCE: The St Johns First Aid staff will be located on site.

SHOWER FACILITIES / CHANGING ROOM FACILITIES: Shower facilities and changing rooms will be available on site. These will not be allocated and will be left open all day. We suggest that nothing is left in the changing rooms unattended as security will not be provided.

REGULATIONS FOR KORONEIHANA RUGBY 2010

RULES: The tournament will be played under the Laws of the Game of Rugby Union Football as framed by the International Rugby Board 2008.

MIHI: A mihi for all Participants and visitors will be held inside the Ngaruawahia Rugby clubrooms at 9am on Sunday 22 August 2010 followed by a management meeting

MANAGEMENT MEETING: All management must attend management meeting following the mihi. Due to late entrees and last minute pull outs a draw will be finalised at this meeting. We can answer any last minute queries for you at this meeting, but hopefully we will have everything sorted for you by this time.

MATCH TIMES: The first games are due to kick off at 10am. All games will be 20 minutes each way with 5 minutes for half time. With the final also being 20 minutes each way and 5 minutes for half time, (note: times are subject to change pending number of team registrations).

POINTS:

1. In each match, four (4) points will be awarded for a win, and two (2) points in the event of a drawn match. One (1) "bonus" point will be awarded to team(s) scoring four or more tries in a match. No extra time to determine a winner will be played in pool matches. Extra time (as per IRB variations, 5 minutes each way first points win the game) will only be played in the final if required.
2. If, on completion of the matches, two or more teams have the same aggregate number of points awarded in accordance with Rule 1, the result will be determined in accordance with the following formulas in order of sequence:
 - a) The winner of the match already played between the teams involved shall have the higher standing.
 - b) If the teams concerned had drawn the match(s) indicated, the team which had scored the most tries in the pool shall have the higher standing.
 - c) The team which has the highest difference of points "for" minus points "against" in their pool matches shall have the higher standing.
 - d) When there is still a tie, the higher standing will be declared by the toss of a coin.

PLAYERS: Each team will comprise 22 players, plus coach/management, and the players will be declared at the start of the tournament (as per team sheets and player registration form attached). Once teams are declared, there is to be no movement of players between teams

RESERVES: A player may be replaced on account of injury or substituted. Rolling substitutions will operate; substituted players may be substituted back on to the field at anytime during the game. Teams may use all seven (7) substitute players and substitutions may only be made at stoppage of play. **(Please note this rule replaces Rules 3.4 and 3.12 of the IRB variations.)**

Reserves should wear jackets or some other clothing when on the sideline to distinguish them from on field players.

ASSEMBLY PRIOR TO GAMES: Teams are required to be present and ready for play 10 minutes before the scheduled playing time to allow referees to make all necessary checks and allow Haka to be performed. This way all checks and Haka will be over before the official game time will commence. All teams performing the Haka must do so on their 10 Metre line. Your team may be defaulted if you are not ready to start on time.

REFEREES: Appointments will be the responsibility of the Waikato Rugby Union Referee's controller appointed for the tournament.

TOUCH JUDGES: Teams may be required to supply a reserve to be touch judge.

TIME KEEPING: A siren will signal the start and ending of games but the Referee will have sole charge over the time keeping of all games and sin binning times.

JUDICIAL:

- a) A player red carded will have an automatic stand down of one (1) game.
- b) A player Sin Binned will stand down for a period of five (5) minutes.
- c) Where touch judges are officially appointed Law 6B (6) applies in relation to their reporting foul play and misconduct to the referee for the match.
- d) Referees will strictly enforce Law 10(2) and in particular 10(2)(b) regarding "voluntarily wasting time"
- e) Negative or derogatory comments to referees or any participants in the tournament will not be tolerated and offenders will be asked to leave the venue.
- f) Any player receiving a second ordering off will take no further part in the tournament unless he is exonerated of the offence for which he was dismissed.

INJURY PREVENTION:

No player shall be permitted to take part in any game without wearing a mouthguard.

Any player suffering from concussion will not be permitted to play again at the tournament.

Decisions of the St Johns Ambulance personnel regarding a player's fitness to continue playing are final.

SIN BINNING: Player's sin binned shall retire to the chairs that will be provided next to the match controllers. Players are to remain seated until their 10 minutes is up and then the Match Controller will inform the Linesman that the player's time is up.

FOOTBALLS: Teams are to supply footballs for their games.

BALL BOYS: Teams are to supply a ball boy for each game.

FOUL LANGUAGE: Players and reserves as well as team officials/supporters will not be permitted to use foul language in and around the fields. - If your team is in a 'plus' situation at this time, divide this score by the number of games **played**
- If your team is in a 'minus' situation at this time then your team has the lower placing
- If two or more teams are in a 'plus' situation, the team/s having the higher/highest result is deemed to have the higher/highest placing

Umpires:

- Each team must provide a competent Umpire, preferably with NNZ qualification.
- Your Umpire may be required to umpire when your team is playing.
