SHANE WIREMU WHITE FACILITATOR PATUA TE NGANGARA

No Ngaati Raukawa, Ngaati Ranginui, Pare Hauraki

Hau ki runga ki te rangi e tu nei. Hau ki raro ki te papa e takoto nei

Ko te wehi ki a Io Matua te kore te timatanga o te whakaaro nui otira ko ngaa mihi mataamua ki te kaupupuri i te mauri o te Kiingitanga, a Kiingi Tuheitia. Ko tona hoa rangatira, a raaua tamariki, me ki, te whare kahui ariki nui tonu.

Pai Marire ki a raatou, otira ki a taatou katoa.

Ko Weraiti te maunga, ko Mangapiko te awa, Ko Te Ohaki ko Tangata ngaa marae, no te whaanau Aoake, me te whaanau Bidois.

Engari ko Shane White toku ingoa.

I au e taiohi ana, e maha oku mahi he. Kua roa taku haerere i teeraa ao kai tarukino, inu waipiro, tahae rawa, patu tangata. tae noa ki te kohurutanga! Na taku noho ki koora ka kite i te huarahi ki te ao Maaori.

No reira hoki ngaa koorero e tuari nei ki mua ki a taatou aroaro.

Tapiri mai ko nga koorero o ngaa whare waananga puta noa te ao e wha ngaa tau e kohi nei I ngaa hua tae atu ki te rangahau a hapori Maaori.

Shane has facilitated the *Patua te Ngangara ki Hoani Waititi Marae* programme since 2003, and delivers a perspective on “P” that is consumer, clinical and whaanau based.

PATUA TE NGANGARA ki Hoanai Waititi Marae Programme

Since its inception, the programme has been delivered to over 75,000 people.

Participants to date include:

‘PATUA TE NGANGARA’ has supported four tribal “P” Raahui to date - Ngaati Whaatua, Ngaati Hine, Ngaati te Rangi, and Murupara whaanau/hapuu.

“P” WAS INVENTED 100 YEARS AGO.

The world is currently facing it’s 5th epidemic and internationally, no rehabilitation models have been developed. There is no medical detoxification.

The international rehabilitation world is now looking to Aotearoa - specifically looking at how the Maaori people have responded...because we have.

SHANE’S BACKGROUND

With a prolific history in the criminal underworld culminating in a life sentence at the age of 18yrs, Shane shares experiences from the user, dealer, “P” user community perspective. Complementing this street based knowledge, is comprehensive research collated from within Maaori whaanau, but also incorporating overseas research, case studies, detoxification and rehabilitation models.

Shane was invited to give input into the ‘Drivers of Crime ministerial’ meeting earlier this year, and addressed the Maaori caucus of the ‘Cutting Edge International AOD Conference’ held in 2008.

OTHER AREAS OF EXPERIENCE:

- 14 years facilitating youth training and alternative education for disaffected and alienated youth;
- 7 years with Kokako training reconnecting urban youth with Tainui waka;
- 20 years involvement in kapa haka including national competitions and a member of Te Whare Tu Taua o Aotearoa (currently pouwha).
- Two years corporate training with the All Blacks (facilitated Team One Corporate Development) •
