



TUKOROIRANGI MORGAN Te Hoe o Tainui Marae

'Tuku' Morgan returns for a second term as Chair of Te Arataura. He is co-negotiator for outstanding Waikato-Tainui claims as well as an ex-officio member on all tribal committees. Tuku holds several executive positions including: Co-chair of the Guardians Establishment Committee; Chair of Te Kawai Taumata, Te Ohu Kaimoana; and he is a member of the Climate Change, Water and Fisheries Iwi Leaders Forums.

PATIENCE TE AO Tauranganui Marae

Patience is deputy chair of Te Arataura and serving her third term as a member of the executive. Patience is an ex-officio member on all tribal committees and earlier this year she was elected Deputy Chair of the Auckland Super City Maori Statutory Board. Patience has a background in policy in the areas of education, marae, kaumaatua, mahi toi, cultural heritage and health.

CHARLES JOE ^{JP mInstD} Ngaa Hau E Wha Marae

Charles has an extensive background in education and was is the current secretary of Te Arataura and Te Kauhanganui. Charles has been involved with various community projects and organisations, and is a founding trustee of a West Auckland Marae. A gazetted Justice of the Peace for 19 years, Charles is a member of the Audit and Risk Committee and has been reappointed as a Director of Tainui Sports Ltd (now Waikato-Tainui Distributions Ltd).

KINGI PORIMA ^{JP} Waipapa Marae

Kingi is a past Chair of Te Arataura and Director of Tainui Group Holdings Ltd and has served on Te Kauhanganui since 2000. He has a background in forestry and is a past Murupara Borough councillor and advisor (Kaitakawaenga) to Te Ruunanga o te Ika Whenua River Claim. GREG MILLER
Kaahui Ariki Representative

Gregory Miller is the Kaahui Ariki representative on the tribe's executive board, Te Arataura. 'Greg' is of Ngaapuhi, Rongowhakaata and Ngaiterangi descent and is currently the General Manager of Toll New Zealand Ltd. Appointed by Kiingi Tuheitia in September 2010, Greg replaces the former Kaahui Ariki representative, the late Lady Raiha Mahuta.

MAXINE MOANA-TUWHANGAI
Mokai Kainga Marae

Maxine is in her first term as a member of Te Kauhanganui and Te Arataura. A chartered accountant, Maxine brings financial knowledge and experience to the board table. She is currently a member of the Audit and Risk Committee and the Human Resources and Remuneration Committee and is also an Accredited Environmental Commissioner, the deputy chairman of The Proprietors of Taharoa C Block Incorporated, and a trustee of the Northern Health School.

RAHUI PAPA
Poohara Marae

Rahui has represented Poohara Marae on Te Kauhanganui since its inception. He has a background in education and is Chair of both the Tainui Teachers Association, and the National Secondary Schools Kapa Haka board. Rahui is a member of the tribe's Human Resources and Remuneration Committee, and the Whakatupuranga 2050 Committee. He is a member of the Iwi Leaders Forum and sits on the WINTEC Board.

Waikare Marae

This is Robert's first term as a board member. He is the current Chair of the Human Resources and Remuneration Committee, and he is Deputy Chair of the Whakatupuranga 2050 Committee. Deputy Chair of Ngaa Muka Development Trust, Robert has chaired the Basic Right Organisation for 12 years and chairs the Board of Trustees for Huntly West Primary School.

Rukumoana Marae

Rukumoana is in her third term as a member of Te Arataura.
